Special Entry Procedure and Mobile Self-diagnosis App Overview

□ Purpose

O To prevent novel coronavirus(COVID-19) from spreading among local communities by checking the contact information available for use within Korea at the entry stage for the Chinese (2.4~) and Hong Kong/Macao (2.12~) entrants and monitor the health status of those special entrants.

□ The Main Content

- (Subject) China (2.4~) and Hong Kong/Macao (2.12~) both domestic and foreign nationals who entered Korea via aircraft and passenger ships
- (Main Content) ① Travel Record Special Declaration for inbound visitors (name, passport number, domestic contact number, address, etc.) ② On-site check whether the contact number can be reached in Korea ③ Monitoring suspected symptoms for 14 days after arrival through mobile self-diagnosis app

□ Detailed Procedure

- (Before departure and in-flight) Distribute instructions regarding special entry procedures and in-flight announcement; Distribute Travel Record Special Declaration which includes information about app installation through URL, QR code and etc.
- (Detection) Requests for health status questionnaire, check for symptoms.
- (Standby for Entry) Write a special quarantine report* and install self-diagnosis app.
 - * (Information) Passport number, name, mobile phone, address of stay in Korea, school/job name in Korea, etc.
- (Special Entry Stage) Check whether the self-diagnosis app is installed, registration of required information, and contact information can be reached in Korea.
- (Post Monitoring) Enter daily occurrence of suspected symptoms through self-diagnosis app, call 1339 in case any related symptom shows and follow the KCDC(Korea Centers for Disease Control & Prevention) call center's directions regarding selected clinics in the area.



Mobile Self-diagnosis App Overview


- O (Name) Mobile Self-diagnosis APP
- O (Main Function) Input personal information (passport number, contact number, name, address, school name, etc.) Daily self-diagnosis (heat, cough, sore throat, etc.), guidance to the 1339 call center & selected clinic information etc.

< Screen Display >

- O (Install) Access URL* or QR** code to install the app.

- "모바일 자가진단 앱"을 설치한 분은 특별검역신고서에 기재한 내용과 동일하게 앱에 입력하여야 합니다. 입국 후 전화번호를 포함한 연락처 등이 변경된 경우 반드시 수정 입력하여야 합니다.
 - 입국 시 부득이하게 "모바일 자가진단 앱"을 설치하지 못한 분은 입국 후라도 반드시 설치하여야 합니다.
- 입국 다음 날부터 14일 간 매일 1회(당일 24시까지) 본인의 증상을 확인하여 증상 발현 여부(Yes/No)를 앱에 입력하여야 합니다.
 - ※ 자가진단 항목 : 발열(37.5도 이상) 또는 발열감, 기침, 인후통/목아픔, 호흡곤란/숨가쁨
 - 위 증상 중 하나라도 있는 경우 앱에 입력하여 주시기 바라며, 이 경우 1339에 전화하거나 가까운 보건소 또는 선별진료소를 방문하시기 바랍니다.
- 앱을 설치하지 않거나 자가진단 항목을 입력하지 않는 경우 확인을 위해 콜센터에서 전화 연락을 할수 있으며, 연락이 안되는 경우 소재 파악을 위한 조치가 있을 수 있습니다.

< 汉语 >

- 安装"自我诊断"手机APP者,需在APP内输入与<特别检疫申报>内容一致的信息。如改变联系电话等个人信息,务必登录APP修改个人信息。
- 入境时未能安装"自我诊断"手机APP者的人,入境后必须安装。
- 入境者需从入境第二天起14天内,每天一次(截止当日24时)确认本人的症状,并在"自我诊断"手机APP中输入以下自我诊断项目。
 - ※ 输入项目(4项):发热(37.5度以上)/有发热感、咳嗽、咽痛、呼吸困难/呼吸急促
- 上述症状中如有任一症状,请输入手机APP,并拨打1339,也可以到附近的保健所或者病毒感染筛查诊所就诊。
- 未安装"自我诊断"手机APP者,或未在规定时间内输入自我诊断症状者,为确认情况呼叫中心将与您联系。在联系不上的情况下,为了把握入境者所在地,本部将采取相应措施。

< ENGLISH >

- O Personal details entered in the "Self Diagnosis App" should coincide with the information submitted in the Travel Record Special Declaration. If there is a change to your personal details, you should update the information on the App.
 - If you have not downloaded the Self Diagnosis App, please download it as soon as possible after entry.
- O You should record whether you have developed any symptoms on the App everyday (by 24:00) for 14 days after the day of entry to Korea.
 - X Self diagnosis symptoms: fever (37.5 or higher) or feverish feeling, cough, sore throat, respiratory difficulties or breathlessness
 - If you have any symptoms listed above, please record it on the app. In this case, you are recommended to call 1339 or visit a nearby health clinic or designated hospital.
- O If you do not download the app or record your health status, you may receive a call from the KCDC center. If you fail to receive the call, measures may be taken to identify your location.
